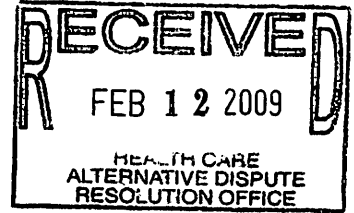

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM**

Gloria Haskins, Plaintiff, by and through her attorney, hereby sues the

Defendant, and in support thereof, says:

1. On February 17, 2006, Defendant repaired a rotator cuff of the left shoulder.
2. During the procedure, the Defendant utilized the wrong kind of sutures.
3. Due to ongoing complaints of pain and discomfort, Plaintiff had a second procedure to remove the sutures as of July 18, 2008.
4. As a further result, Plaintiff has continued to have significant scarring and pain in her shoulder.
5. Defendant breached the standard of care by failing to utilize the proper sutures during the operative procedure, and was otherwise negligent, and as a direct and proximate result Plaintiff was injured as stated above and in other respects.



WHEREFORE, Plaintiff claims damages against the Defendant in excess of Thirty Thousand  
(\$30,000.00) Dollars.
